

Several rounds with different number of holes

Multi-rounds tournament on 9-holes and 18-holes

As an example, we play a 4-round tournament in which the first round is played over 18 holes, the second round over 9 holes, the third round over 9 holes and the fourth round again over 18 holes. 27 holes will be played on 27 holes each.

First of all, we need 72 holes for **4x18 holes „planned“** (just as in the history of golf a round always had 18 holes).

This number of holes cannot be seen anywhere later during the set up of the game! **Please leave this number of rounds as such throughout the game! The individual round setting explained below only works with the number of holes that „thinks“ there are 18 holes for each round.**
